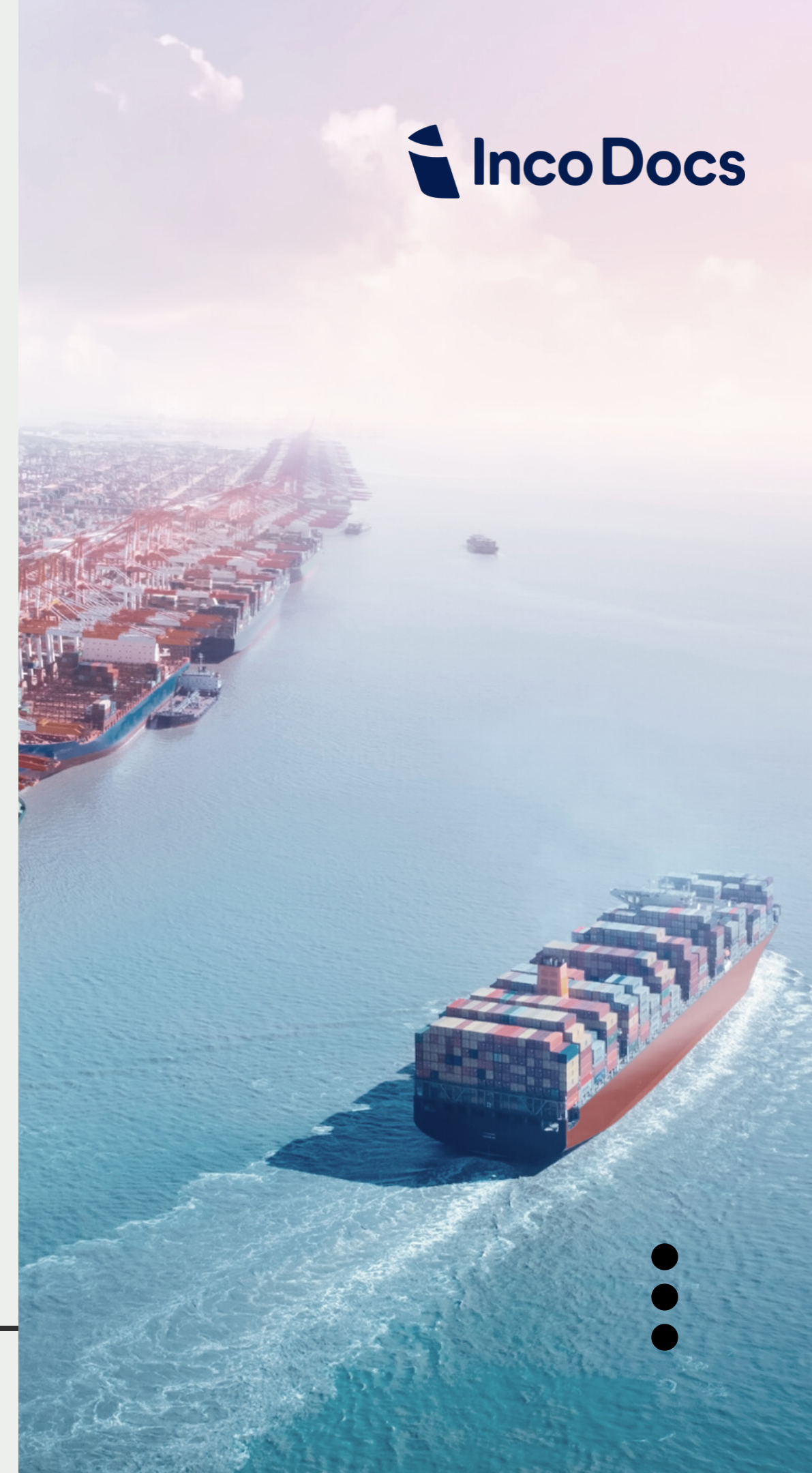

# REMOTE CULTURE

## CREATE A POSITIVE WORK CULTURE

**Trust your team to get the work done. Don't micromanage the team. If you don't trust people to get the work done, the morale will nosedive, along with actual progress.**

**Stop forcing your team to come into the office just to get the basic work done. If you've spent the time to setup your team with the right tools, they will be able to get the job done working remotely. This will also cut down travel time to and from work and improve employee morale. Post COVID-19, more employees will want to work for a company that supports remote working.**

**Encourage people to speak up with ideas - don't be blindsided by any new or innovative ways to do things.**







# TEAM MEETINGS



## KEEP COMMUNICATION OPEN TO EVERYONE

**If communication can't be resolved over text, call to clarify information and keep moving forward.**

**Hold a Monday morning team meeting to set the goals and expectations for the week. Review the progress at each Monday morning meeting and reset for the beginning of the new week.**

**Hold a short daily 'standup' at the start of each workday. This could be done over a call, or with a simple post to a team communication channel. During the standup each team member can mention a short “Win From Yesterday”, a summary of “Working on Today” and a list of any “Blockers” - i.e. things that they need other team members to do, to unblock them to make progress.**





# WORK ENVIRONMENT

## CREATE A COMFORTABLE PLACE TO WORK

**Make sure that you spend the time with each person in the team to ensure they have what they need to work comfortably. Ensure that everybody is added to your cloud software.**

**Invest in hardware to make their job easier. Make sure everyone has a good set of headphones (to suit phones and computers) and a comfortable chair and desk. Buy an extra computer monitor to make day to day work easier and more efficient.**

**Do you really need to print? If setup with the right online software, there will be no need to manually print, sign and store physical copies of documents.**

**Encourage your team to get up and walk around periodically to stretch their muscles and give their minds a short break. If it's safe, try to have lunch outside or in fresh air.**





# TURN UNCERTAINTY INTO AN OPPORTUNITY

In summary, this period of change may come as a shock to your business and operations. But if handled well, it's an opportunity to set up better processes to actually improve your business. Take the time to assess your process and setup cloud software to operate more efficiently. When the market turns around your business will be in a position to handle more work without the added costs.

You should also consider how your company can provide a more flexible working environment post the COVID-19 crisis. Over the past few years many companies have already started giving employees the flexibility to work from home to help work in with their daily lives. People really appreciate the flexibility of remote work and if companies are too strict and rigid, employee satisfaction will decline and people will start looking for jobs that support flexibility and remote work environments.
